Furnish all labor and material as detailed in this scope of work for the following projects.

Project (1) Purchase of battery powered extrication tools as follows:

Spreader: Maximum length of (37"), with a minimum lower spread force of (50,000 LBS), minimum pull force of (23,000 LBS) and a minimum spread width of (32") powered by Milwaukee (18V) batteries (2) included with the tool.
